

6th Grade Summer Reading Assignment

Analyzing novels is not always fun or easy, now it is your time to showcase your knowledge through a creative outlet. The projects are all to be done independently. Choose one of the options below.

iMovie- Recreate a scene using iMovie. You can either film yourself recreating a scene or you can compile clips from the internet. Be creative with this. You can put music in the background and/or do voice overs. Editing on iMovie is similar to TikTok!

Alternate Ending- *Ghost* is the first book in a four book series and ends with a cliffhanger. Finish the ending of chapter 10 with how the novel should end. Stay true to the voice of the author, use dialogue, and provide descriptive imagery. The reader should be able to feel like they are continuing to read the novel.

Quote Connection with Visual- Create a visual using a quote from the novel for inspiration. The visual must relate to the quote and the quote needs to be represented on the piece of art.

Shoes- *Ghost*'s shoes represent much more than the fact that they are merely a pair of shoes. Re-create *Ghost*'s no name brand pair and the silver bullets. Make sure you clearly state what those shoes mean to him and how they are represented. Think of this choice as an advertisement.

Sports Analysis- Research why sports are beneficial for teenagers, not just physically but emotionally as well. Choose your format how you want to display your information. This can be a report, Google Slide, a paper, or another format.
